In addition, I agree to assume **ALL** responsibilities and abide with the rules and regulations in conjunction with the exclusive right to use the Pavilion and/or Band Shell at the Tittabawassee Township Park and its facilities. A Certificate of Liability Insurance must be presented at time of reservation for any party bringing in activities not already a fixture at the park.

I understand that this agreement is for the exclusive right to use the Pavilion and/or Band Shell only. The baseball diamonds, volleyball pits, and horse shoe pits are on a first come, first serve basis.

Maximum seating capacity for one (1) Pavilion is approximately 120 people. For any party expecting over 150, it is requested that both Pavilions be reserved.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONDUCT AND USE
OF PARKS AND PARK FACILITIES**

Section 1. Hours:

- a. The Park will be open from 7:00 a.m. to sunset.

Section 2. Conduct:

In the Township Park no person shall:

- a. Injure, remove or otherwise mutilate or disturb any plant or wildlife.
- b. Deface, mar or in any way damage any building, structure, sign, equipment or other physical feature.
- c. Enter any building or area at anytime when it is not open to the general public.
- d. Build an open fire upon the lawn or elsewhere except in the places provided for that purpose.
- e. Use profane or obscene language.
- f. Conduct himself in a disorderly or indecent manner.
- g. Fail to keep animal or animals owned by him under control nor fail to assume the responsibility for any damage caused by such animals.
- h. Dispose of garbage, rubbish, or refuse, except in proper containers as provided. Only refuse generated at the Park to be deposited in refuse containers:
- i. Play any radio, phonograph or musical instrument so loudly that it disturbs other persons.
- j. No swimming allowed in pond at the Township Park.
- k. Overload pavilion electrical by plugging in too many electrical items.

Section 3. Activities requiring prior approval or written permit from Parks and Recreation Board or its representative.

- a. Parade, drill, exhibition, political or religious meeting or sporting event.
- b. Temporary lodging in a trailer or tent or camping out.
- c. Use of pond for water type events.
- d. Advertising canvassing, soliciting, vending, or renting any service, merchandise or object.
- e. Scheduled league sporting events.
- f. Reservation of pavilions and band shell.
- g. Other park facilities such as ball diamonds, volleyball pits, and horse shoe pits are reserved only under very special circumstances.

Section 4. Motor Vehicle Operation:

- a. Speed limit is 15 miles per hour.
- b. No person shall **drive or park anywhere except on established drives or parking areas.**
- c. All vehicles shall be operated in a safe and cautious manner at all times.
